If you have diabetes, your body cannot make proper use of glucose so it builds up in the blood and isn't able to be used as fuel, leading to the three main symptoms of diabetes:

Polyuria - the need to urinate frequently

Polydipsia - increased thirst & fluid intake

Polyphagia - increased appetite

There are two main types of diabetes:

Type 1 diabetes, Type 2 diabetes

- Type 1 diabetes is a form of diabetes mellitus that is most common in children but can be diagnosed at any age.
- Diabetes Mellitus Type 2, also known as type 2 diabetes, is a globally common metabolic disorder affecting around 3 million people in the UK alone.
